Moskovich: One of the most appealing extra-early tomatoes. Fruits are early, deep red, and cold tolerant. Rich flavor. Smooth and globe-shaped. 4-6 oz. with a small stem scar. Indeterminate.



Prudens Purple: 1 pound fruits with excellent sweet, balanced classic tomato flavor. A great choice for new gardeners looking for a dependable heirloom beefsteak tomato.



Rose de Berne: Beautiful rose-pink Swiss heirloom with big flavor and crack resistance. Medium sized fruits, with soft yet durable skin, have an even balance of acidity and sweetness that is perfect for a sandwich or in a quick tomato sauce. Earlier to ripen than other larger varieties and a consistent producer well into the season.



Principe Borghese: Italian heirloom bred for sun-drying, this low moisture variety maintains more flavor when dried than do other varieties. Slightly oval, 1 oz fruits. Prized in Italian cooking when reconstituted in olive oil, they can also be crushed into small flakes to quickly thicken a thin sauce while adding a rich tomato flavor.



Rutgers: Also known as the Jersey tomato, was the most popular tomato variety in the world before the era of mechanized farming began a change in breeding for durability over flavor. It is an open pollinated beefsteak.



Tang: Drought-tolerant, flavorful orange slicer packed with beta carotene for a nutritional boost.



Brandywine: Some of the most popular heirloom tomatoes grown in North America. They are known for their large fruits, great taste, and pumpkin-like ridges.



Pear: Pear tomato or teardrop tomato is an indeterminate heirloom tomato. There are yellow, orange, and red varieties of this tomato; the one being sold is red. They are mildly sweet, and are in the shape of a pear, but smaller.



Sweetie Cherry: Indeterminate cherry variety that produces heavy clusters of super sweet cherry tomatoes. Sweetie is known for its low acidity and high sugar content.



Golden Nugget Cherry: Their sunny yellow skin is thinner than most other cherry tomato varieties, giving them a tender texture. They are juicy with a mild, well-balanced sweet flavor and a low acid content.



Supernova Grape: Truly the standout in our star-studded grape tomato collection, Supernova impresses with both aesthetics and flavor. Red flesh with yellow marbling inside and out, and a unique mini-roma shape born on indeterminate plants.
